On March 18, 2022, I submitted comments on the Civil Practice Committee's report. Among my comments was concern about "how to determine if a judgment is actually final and the (perhaps more than) suggestion in some cases that a dismissal without prejudice can never be final. See *Grow Co., Inc. v. Chokshi*, 403 N.J. Super. 443, 460 (App. Div. 2008)." I wish to draw the Court's attention to the Appellate Division's April 11, 2022, opinion, approved for publication, in *Devers v. Devers* (attached) which seems to discuss the same concerns (see especially pages 8-10). Both the prospective appellant and respondent have a legitimate interest in certainty as to whether and when an order may and must be appealed.
