

NOTICE TO THE BAR
ONLINE ATTORNEY REGISTRATION AND PAYMENT -- REMINDER

There is less than one month remaining for licensed New Jersey attorneys to complete their annual registration and remit payment through the Judiciary's Attorney Online Registration and Payment Center at <http://www.judiciary.state.nj.us/attyreg/index.htm> without having to pay a late fee. The **March 31, 2017** deadline for timely registration and payment is fast approaching.

Attorneys must complete the annual registration and payment electronically. Newly admitted attorneys, notwithstanding exemption from any payment, are nonetheless required to complete the registration process and must do so online. Information containing user ID and temporary password has been mailed to each new attorney. Attorneys must further certify to completion of the required continuing legal education (CLE) credits.

Attorneys who do not make the required payment or complete the necessary CLE credits will be deemed ineligible to practice law by Supreme Court order. Ineligible attorneys are considered "not in good standing" and may not practice law. Any attorney who is declared ineligible for seven consecutive years will have his or her license to practice law in New Jersey administratively revoked by Supreme Court order.
