Recently the Supreme Court was requested to express its views as to where responsibility rests for the prosecution of defendants charged with violating the terms of probation - on the prosecutor's office or on the probation department.

The Supreme Court considered this matter at its conference on July 1, 1966 and concluded that such matters are the responsibility of the County Prosecutor and should be prosecuted by his or her office and not by a member of the probation staff.
