- A. The Supreme Court has asked that we request all court reporters to include the following in the transcripts of all criminal proceedings:
  - 1. The time when the case goes to the jury and the jury departs from the courtroom to consider the case.
  - 2. The time if and when the jury should return to the courtroom with questions to be answered by the court.
  - 3. The time when the jury returns with its verdict.

## EDITOR=S NOTE

The second paragraph of this directive, dealing with the reporter-s obligation to notify all other parties to a case of a transcript request, has been deleted because the provision doesn't conform to practice.
