CASE MANAGEMENT ORDER NO. 3

THIS MATTER having come before the Court for a Case Management Conference on June 11, 2009, and counsel for plaintiffs and counsel for defendant Bristol-Myers Squibb Company ("BMS") having been present and for good cause shown,

IT IS on this 8th day of July, 2009, ORDERED that, except to the extent inconsistent with the terms of the within Case Management Order ("CMO"), all prior CMO's remain in full force and effect, and it is further ORDERED as follows:

1. "New Complaints" are those which have been or will be served after the issuance of Case Management Order Number 2, December 1, 2008. As to all "new cases," plaintiffs will submit Answers to Interrogatories as specified in Case Management Order Number 2 as well as plaintiffs' medical records within 45 days of the service of the Answer to the Complaint.

2. Within 60 days of the date of this Order, BMS will produce all internal reports and e-mails relating to possible environmental contamination on-site at the BMS New Brunswick facility as well as off-site in the areas in close proximity to the New Brunswick facility. These reports and e-mails will be produced in a searchable electronic format, ^{acceptable to both sides.} Within 20 days of the date of this Order, plaintiffs' counsel and their I.T. experts will meet and confer with BMS counsel and its I.T. experts in order to resolve any issues related to this production.

3. Plaintiffs may conduct depositions of BMS personnel with knowledge about contamination at the Site to the extent that any personnel are known or become identified. Within 30 days of the date of this Order, BMS will provide plaintiffs' counsel with the names of the currently-employed corporate representatives most knowledgeable about contamination at the Site.

4. On or before September 1, 2009, plaintiffs will provide BMS with the names of BMS personnel whom they wish to depose.

5. The next Case Management Conference will be held on September 10, 2009 at 1:30 P.M., at the Atlantic County Courthouse, Courtroom 3-B, 1201 Bacharach Boulevard, Atlantic City, New Jersey.
