
1. Altom Maglio, Esq., shall abide by the New Jersey Court Rules including all disciplinary rules, R. 1:20-1 and R. 1:28-2.

3. Altom Maglio, Esq., shall immediately notify the Court of any matter affecting his standing at the Bar of any other jurisdiction.
4. Altom Maglio, Esq., shall have all pleadings, briefs and other papers filed with the Court signed by an attorney of records authorized to practice in New Jersey, who shall be held responsible for them, the conduct of the litigation and the attorney admitted herein.

8. The *pro hac vice* admission of Altom Maglio, Esq., will automatically terminate for failure to make the initial and any annual payment required by R. 1:20-1(b) and R. 1:28-2.

9. Non-compliance with any of the terms of this Order shall constitute grounds for removal.
