**ORDERED** as follows:

1. By July 8, 2021, Plaintiff shall serve Defendant with updated authorizations and an updated Long Form Fact Sheet.
2. Counsel for Defendant, Janssen Pharmaceuticals, Inc., shall take Plaintiff's deposition within forty-five (45) days of receiving Plaintiff's current and up-to-date medical records from all applicable healthcare providers.

3. Plaintiff shall serve Defendant with causation expert report(s) as to the allegations against Janssen no later than September 20, 2021.
4. The next Case Management Conference shall be conducted telephonically, unless otherwise Ordered by the Court, on August 24, 2021 at 10:00 A.M. Any agenda items and submissions shall be submitted to the Court and served on Defendant via regular and certified mail, return receipt requested, no later than 12 o'clock noon on August 17, 2021.
5. All parties, including Plaintiff, are required to attend and participate in the next scheduled telephonic Case Management Conference. Failure to appear at the next Case Management Conference may result in a dismissal of this matter in accordance with R. 4:23-2.
6. Defendant shall serve Plaintiff with a copy of this Order by regular and certified mail, return receipt requested, and recognized overnight delivery service (e.g., Fed Ex, UPS, etc.) upon the Plaintiff at Plaintiff's last known address, and shall upload Proof of Service of same, within ten (10) days of the date hereof.
